STILLWATER HONORED FOR TOP INNOVATIVE PROGRAM

OKLAHOMA CITY(September 16, 2016) – The City of Stillwater was the recipient of the 2016 Municipal Innovations Award for population over 10,000 for its “Stillwater Energy Center” (SEC) project during today’s Oklahoma Municipal League Annual Awards Breakfast.

The new Stillwater Energy Center (SEC) project included the construction of a new power generation building which houses three natural gas fired generation units capable of producing 56 megawatts of electricity, operations and administration complex and a new electrical transmission and distribution substation. This plant is a modern marvel for the state, it is extremely environmentally friendly and it is the first plant internal of the United States using the large engines. Due to the size of the engines, this technology has only been installed in the coastal regions. These engines can be brought online and to full load in less than 10 minutes.

The City of Stillwater is providing clean, low cost energy to its customers, supporting a national effort to reduce harmful greenhouse gas emissions and promoting economic growth. SEC Stillwater is leading the state and the nation in clean energy production.
