### **Oklahoma Municipal League Hosts New Officials Institute (NOI) In Lawton**

(March 17, 2016) – Throughout the year the Oklahoma Municipal League (OML) provides an intensive educational program specifically tailored for individuals that are newly elected officials as well as experienced officials that want to keep up to date on leading municipal issues. OML trains over 400 municipal officials each year in this workshop.

The upcoming New Municipal Officials Institute session will be held at the Great Plains Technology Center on March 24th from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. in Lawton, Oklahoma. These workshops offer eight hours of Certified Municipal Officials credit and State Certification requirements for the MC&T Certification Program.
