Municipal Code Management, LLC, (MCM) is a code management business created to assist municipalities not only in the ordinance compilation process, but in the entire codification process including the process of remaining up-to-date and compliant with Oklahoma's codification statutes. MCM was founded by two Oklahoma attorneys who in the course of practicing law recognized that many municipalities in Oklahoma are not compliant with the codification standards outlined under Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The consequences of noncompliance include unenforceability of penal ordinances, the inability to fine more than \$50.00, and even the potential for a class action lawsuit against the noncompliant municipality. It was in the face of this widespread lack of municipality compliance that MCM was established in order to provide a simple, quick, and cost-effective remedy to this serious problem.

The goal of MCM is to identify the obstacles that stand in the way of municipalities remaining compliant with Oklahoma's codification process and to provide services that resolve those obstacles. It is with this goal as the driving force that MCM strives to make compliance in codification attainable for all municipalities in Oklahoma regardless of the size. Most municipalities that we have spoken with cite one of three reasons for their trouble with codification: **Knowledge**, **Finances**, and **Ability**. While the services provided by MCM are non-legal in nature, MCM brings the knowledge of its attorney founders to the table to ensure that each municipality has complied with the statutory steps for codification. MCM works to maintain our clients' codes at a low fixed annual fee that is a fraction of our competitors' price, with no additional charge above that fixed fee for recodification or supplementation of the code. Also, with MCM taking the entire process of codification off the shoulders of the municipality, our clients don't have to put these tasks on their employees.

The services MCM offers include: 1) **Codification** (or updating previous codifications) of the municipality's ordinance book; 2) **Delivery** of codified ordinances, notice of hearing for posting, and resolution for codification; 3) Correct and complete **recording and filing** of necessary documents; 4) **Continued monthly contact** so that your ordinances stay up to date and compliant; 5) A **fixed flat fee**, subject to terms, for services on an optional annually renewed contract; 6) **Online posting** and updating on our website of your municipality's codified ordinances; and 7) **Recodification every two years** instead of the base level biennial supplements.

It is our goal that each municipality can come into compliance with the required codification process, and we hope that you share this goal with us.
