This following sample was assembled from multiple municipalities and provides the basic foundation for your municipality to craft a model ordinance. OML sample ordinances are intended to provide a basis for drafting an ordinance which meets the needs of municipalities. They should be considered as open to modification. Rarely does one policy statement reflect the needs and concerns of all municipalities. Sample ordinances should not substitute for or replace the advice of the city/town's legal counsel.
