

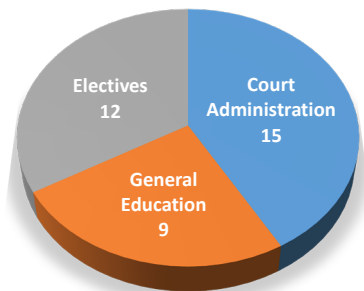

• How do I become certified?

1. Be an active OMCCA member
2. Register for OSU Certification Program
3. Attend courses
(annual conferences, workshops and other regional training sessions)
4. 36 credits are required for certification



• How do I keep track of credit?

OSU keeps track of all credit. Transcripts are sent annually via email, but you can request one at any time online from the CEPD website (listed below) or by emailing OSU. For any questions regarding transcripts, please email marisa.dyess@okstate.edu

• How much does certification cost?

- OMCCA annual dues are \$55 - paid to OMCCA
- OSU Certification Program is a one-time \$20 fee - paid to OSU
- Conference and workshop fees vary. Fees are published in the brochures
