Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) under the State & Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) program totaling approximately \$; and

WHEREAS, the SLFRF final rule delivers broader flexibility and greater simplicity in the program,
offering a standard allowance for revenue loss of \$10 million, allowing recipients to select between a standard amount of revenue loss or complete a full revenue loss calculation. Recipients that select the
standard allowance may use that amount for government services, with streamlined reporting
requirements; and
WHEREAS, the town or City will track all expenditures, including ARPA SLFRF funded
expenses through theTown or City_=s Finance Department accounting system for the purpose of
accurate accounting and annual audit verification; and
WHEREAS, this funded action has been determined necessary and needed to demonstrate ongoing
support for theTown or City=s efforts with the methods of funding not reasonably foreseen at the
time of the adoption of the budget; and
NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town or City Board of
Board of Commissioners or Trustees does hereby declare its intention to claim the standard allowance
